Bat House Installation Quote:

Service areas are typically offered for Alabama, Georgia, and Tennessee, but may be offered in other locations pending other projects. All bat houses are approved by Bat Conservation International.

Traditional Houses:

All installations include 4" x 6" x 16' treated post, and minimum 80 lbs. of concrete mix, and post setting 2.5' deep minimum.

- Building installation: Siting and install fee of \$495.00
 - \$45 for each additional single mount location
- Single post installation: Siting and install fee of \$495.00
 - Models include:
 - Colony Cabin 3 Chamber* - starting at \$139.00
 - Colony Lodge 4 Chamber* - starting at \$265.00
 - Colony Condo 5 Chamber* - starting at \$285.00
 - Super Rocket Roost - starting at \$375.00
 - \$85 for each additional single post location, including the post and cement.
- Double post installation fee: Siting and install fee of \$595.00.¹
 - \$170 for each additional double post location, including the posts and cement.
 - Models include:
 - ColonyCondo Super Duplex Bat House - starting at \$785.00
 - BCM Modular Bat Condo – starting at \$1,820.00
- Optional post protector \$50 per post. Recommended for sites that are often damp or wet. Post protectors may greatly extend the life of the post at ground level.

Please note that the above sample installation fees **do not** include the bat house or pole mount which must be purchased separately or added into your total installation estimate. Not all bat houses require pole mounts, but those that do are indicated above. Two bat houses can be mounted back-to-back on a single post. Please specify if more than two posts/bat house locations are desired on the quote request form.

*Requires separate mounting kit. Must specify if mounting to wood, siding, or stone/brick.

BradenBark Houses:

BradenBark™ is an artificial bark roost specifically designed to support bark-roosting bats, including the federally endangered Indiana bat (*Myotis sodalis*). Developed through years of research and monitoring by Copperhead and Fort Knox Army Installation biologists, BradenBark™ replicates the microclimate and visual characteristics of natural bark roosts. In addition to the Indiana bat, it has been utilized by other species such as the federally threatened northern long-eared bat (*Myotis septentrionalis*), little brown bat (*Myotis lucifugus*), big brown bat (*Eptesicus fuscus*), and evening bat (*Nycticeius humeralis*). (Copperhead Environmental Consulting).

Each installation includes a pole at least 25 feet tall, set approximately 5 feet into the ground. For optimal results, we recommend grouping 3 to 5 houses together, depending on the site. Because of the pole size, heavy equipment such as a mini excavator is needed for installation. If you have access to equipment that can assist with handling and installing these poles, please note this on the quote request form.
